¹ A ¾" meter and tap will be installed at no additional cost. A 1" meter and tap will cost an additional \$400.00.

² The cost for road bores is \$1,500.00 minimum under ideal conditions. Boring or cutting through rocky terrain will incur additional costs. If the actual cost of the road bore is \$1,501.00 or more, an 10% (ten percent) of the actual cost will be added to the amount due. A cost will be quoted on an individual basis. The maximum distance for installation of a benefit unit from the water main line will be 15'. **The road bore is required to be paid in full prior to the meter being installed for water usage. Therefore, the District will invoice for any additional cost for the road bore and payment must be received by the District before the meter will be installed. Example: Road bore actual cost is \$2,000.00. Customer will be billed for \$700.00 (\$2,000 actual cost plus 10% less the initial payment of \$1,500.00).**

³ Service will be reconnected at no additional charge upon payment of billing and all fees.

⁴ Service reconnected after payment of billing and all fees, and reconnected after normal work hours, will be charged an additional \$25.00 (original \$50.00 disconnect fee plus \$25.00 additional fee total \$75.00 after-hours disconnect fee).

⁵ Intentional tampering, or destruction to the unit on top of the meter box or tampering or destruction in any way to the meter itself will result in fines and/or prosecution. If the destruction is accidental, the fines may be waived for the first incident at the discretion of the field personnel, office personnel and/or the Board of Directors. Any and all instances will be reviewed on an individual basis.

⁶ A reinstallation fee will be charged if the meter is reinstalled within thirty (30) days of the customer's request that the meter be removed. If the meter is reinstalled after thirty (30) days of being removed, there will be no charge for the installation.

⁷ Minimum charge is for 1,000 gallons (\$40.00) regardless of the actual number of gallons if the initial purchase for the day of purchase is less than 1,000 gallons.

⁸ If customer request a copy of their original billing, the cost for such printing of the original billing will be \$1.00.

⁹ Lake Permit/Raw Water Hauled (agriculture only) is limited to 2,000 gallons maximum per load.

NOTICE

Effective 2/4/03 the Board of Trustees for the Town of Mounds voted to create an inspection fee for the inspection of a sewer tap. The following situations will have a \$25.00 inspection fee assessed.

- Repairing an existing sewer tap
- Moving an existing sewer tap
- Creating a new sewer tap

If any type of work affects a sewer tap or the main sewer line where a sewer tap exists, the customer must contact City Hall for an inspection.
